 - a. His Father takes note (vs.11)
2. Joseph sold into slavery (Gen 37) **0**
 - a. Reuben tries to rescue Joseph (vs. 21-22; 29-30)
3. Joseph and Potiphar's wife (Gen 39) **0**
 - a. Joseph find favor with Potiphar and becomes head servant
 - b. Joseph fears God (vs. 9)
4. Joseph in Prison **9**
 - a. Joseph finds favor in prison
 - b. Interprets two dreams **11**
5. Joseph answers Pharaoh's Dream (Gen 41) **12**
 - a. Predicts great famine
 - b. Pharaoh makes Joseph second in command
 - c. Joseph marries
 - d. Joseph stores more grain than can be measured
6. Joseph's brothers come to Egypt **23**
7. Jacob and all his people come to live in Egypt **23**
