 - Moses sees God
 - New Tablets

Leviticus (27 chapter):

- Aaron and his sons (9,10)

Numbers (36 chapters):

- (11-14)
 - People complain
 - Quale and plague
 - Miriam and Aaron Oppose Moses
 - Spies sent into Canaan
- (16-17)
 - Korah's Rebellion
 - Aaron's Staff Buds
- (20-27)
 - The Waters of Meribah
 - Moses strikes the rock
 - Bronze Serpent

- King Sihon Defeated
- King Og Defeated
- Balaam
- Baal Worship at Peor and the Zeal of Phinehas
- Joshua to succeed Moses
- (31-32)
 - Vengeance on Midian
 - Reuben and Gad Settle in Gilead

Deuteronomy (34 chapters): Moses' final sermon (34- death of Moses)

137 chapters in all
