1. Hannah (1:11)
2. Eli
 - a. Sons were worthless (2:12,23-26)
 - b. God rejects Eli (2:30)
 - c. Death of sons foretold (2:35)
3. Samuel chosen; Eli dies (3:19-21) (4:17-18)
4. The people ask for a king (8:4-8,20)
5. Saul chosen and wins first battle (Chapters 9-12) (11:7,12-15)
6. Saul's 2 strikes (13:8-14) (15:3;19-22)
 - a. Saul's sin not only changed his destiny, but also that of his son, Jonathan.
7. Saul pursues David until his death.
 - a. Saul knows that David is the Lord's anointed.
 - b. Sin has no limits...
 - Trying to kill David
 - Uses his daughter for wicked purpose. (18:17-25)
 - Attempts to kill his son. (20:33)
 - Slaughtering the priests and the village of Nob. (22:6-23)
 - Consulting a witch. (Chapter 28)
 - Commits suicide. (31:3-6)
